After the service, and whilst the register was being well and truly signed, Mendelssohn's "Wedding March" was played on the organ by Miss Florence Grierson, cousin of the bride. This young lady possesses musical power of exceptional ability, and showed herself to be an efficient organiste.

After due acknowledgment to the Divine Father of all good and perfect gifts by the reverend chairman, and the company having done full justice to the lavish dainties provided, Miss Florence Grierson gave a nicely rendered pianoforte solo, which was followed by a fine baritone song by Mr. T. Hadden.

Songs by Miss Grierson and Mr. Albert Emery were sung, the singers receiving well-deserved applause for their vocal efforts.
