Our obituary contains a notice of the death of Mrs. Grierson, of Victoria-parade, on, Monday, aged eighty-six. This lady came to the colonies in the year 1810 with Governor Macquarie, her husband being a corporal in the 73rd Regiment. After a four years' residence in Paramatta and Tasmania, she accompanied her husband to India, from whence he was invalided after long service. Mrs. Grierson again came to Australia in 1839, landing from the first free emigrant ship that reached these waters, the David Clarke. Her husband died fifteen years ago. She has left a large number of descendants here.
